We were most excited to interview **Blake and Sheri Stehr**, from Covenant Fellowship Church. - We introduced **the Timothy Scholarships**. Named for Paul's encouragement to Timothy to "set the believers an example" (1 Tim. 4:12), these are referral scholarships that will pay for Bridge Year students' tuition next year.
- We talked about new academic programs. Our new **high school dual** enrollment program is helping Seniors get a jump on their college education—and accelerating their discipleship. We're also developing a two-year associates program that will pave the way for transfer credits to other colleges.
- We heard about the difference **our new Practical Theology** class is making. Students are getting to read from and discuss some of the very best books that have shaped Sovereign Grace over the last 40 years. Packer, Sproul, Stott, Owen, you name it.
- And we want to tell you about how Trinity College is working with Trinitas Classical Academy to offer **online classes for middle school and high school students** next year.
